Cattle Fee: \$75.00/run if reserved by July 15. Late Cattle Fee \$115.00

Ranch Trail Equipment Fee: \$10/horse flat fee

AQHA Processing Fee: \$10/horse/judge, if entered in AQHA classes

Stalls, Shavings & Accommodation Information

Stalls—\$30/night. Stalls & RV spaces available upon arrival at the facility.

Shavings—\$11/bag. *No outside shavings allowed.*

Grounds fee for non-stalled horses—\$20 flat fee

Must have Coggins to enter the grounds & 30-day health certificate for non-Texas residents.
Coggins certificates WILL be checked at the gate.
