## Show Rules

### All breeds are welcome!

- AQHA rules apply for all classes regarding attire & equipment. AQHA Rulebook will be used as a guideline for class procedures & patterns. All judge placings will be considered final.
- Horse/rider combinations may **not** cross-enter Walk-Trot and Walk-Trot-Lope within their division.
- AQHA cross-entry class rules for Ranch classes do not apply (i.e., you may enter Western Pleasure & Ranch Riding or Trail & Ranch Trail). Horses are expected to have a ranch-type appearance in Ranch classes; however, bands/fake tails in ranch classes will not result in disqualification.
- Youth are defined as 18-years-old & under as of January 1 of the current year; Adults are 19-years-old & over as of January 1 of the current year.
- English or Western attire is permitted in Halter & Showmanship.

## Show Prizes!

Prizes will be awarded for the All-Around & Reserve All-Around winners in each of the following divisions:

Walk-Trot Youth, Youth, Walk-Trot Adult, Adult

To be eligible for the All-Around, a horse-rider combination must show in at least 1 in-hand class (halter or showmanship) and at least 3 riding classes. Points will be tabulated using a 10-point system. Ties will be

broken by number of 1st places received. If a tie still exists, ties will be broken with a coin flip.

Ribbons will be awarded to class placings 1st through 6th.

## PQHA Fall Buckle Series Guidelines

1. Awards will be based on a horse/rider combination for all divisions.
2. Division are as follows: Walk-Trot Youth, Youth, Walk-Trot Adult, Adult.
3. Buckles will be awarded for the High-Point winner in each of the divisions stated above. Prizes will be awarded to the Reserve High-Point winner in each division.
4. Horse/rider combinations must participate at both PQHA Fall Series shows (September & November show) to be eligible for High-Point awards.
5. To be eligible for the Fall Buckle Series prizes, the horse/exhibitor combination must show in at least 1 in-hand class (halter or showmanship) at each show, along with a minimum of 3 riding classes at each show.
6. Points are tabulated using a 10-point system. Ties will be broken by the number of 1st places.

**High-Point, Walk-Trot divisions:** Buckles will be awarded to the horse/rider combination who accumulates the most points in the below classes. At least 1 in-hand class and 3 riding classes are required at each show to be eligible.
