AQHA Classes: \$17.00/class/judge

PQHA All-Breed Classes: \$10/class/judge

Office Fee: \$10/horse if entered before July 15

Late Office Fee, after July 15: Additional \$15/horse flat fee

Cattle Fee: \$100.00/run if reserved by July 15. Late Cattle Fee \$100.00/horse flat fee after July 15.

Trail Equipment Fee: \$10/horse flat fee (ranch trail & city trail)

AQHA Processing Fee: \$10/horse/judge, if entered in AQHA classes

Pre-entry information is available at www.panhandleqha.com. Late entries are not guaranteed fresh cattle.

PQHA All-Breed classes must conform to AQHA rules regarding attire & equipment.

Stall & Hotel Information

Stalls: \$35/night RVs: \$40/night

Shavings: \$11/bag. *No outside shavings allowed.*

Grounds fee for non-stalled horses: \$20 flat fee/horse

***Stalls, shavings, & RV spots will be purchased through the fairgrounds
upon arrival at the facility at the stall office.****

Must have Coggins to enter the grounds & 30-day health certificate for non-Texas residents.

Coggins & Health certificates WILL be checked at the gate.

All-Breed Division

- ◆ All-Breed Working Western Rail

• Reminders:

- You cannot cross-enter Working Cow Horse/Boxing classes, Ranch Riding/Western Pleasure, Working Western Rail/Western Pleasure, Ranch Trail/Trail, or Halter/Performance Halter under the same judge.
- To show in Performance Halter, horses must either have a Performance ROM or show in an AQHA riding class under the same judge.

- Class points are tabulated using a 9-point system.
